GOVERNOR SIGNS WILDLIFE NUISANCE BILL

On Dec. 6, Governor Evers signed WAMA-spearheaded state legislation codifying nuisance wildlife management at airports. See Act 51 HERE.

Control of nuisance wildlife is crucial to safe operations at the state's airports. Act 51 provides exceptions to state statutes, which limit the ability of designated personnel to manage nuisance wildlife at a public-use airport or an airport under the exclusive control of the National Guard or U.S. Department of Defense.

FAA REAUTHORIZATION AND OTHER UPDATES

Before the Dec. 31 expiration of the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) statutory authorities, Congress passed a second short-term extension of aviation excise taxes, spending authority, and policies. The measure was signed into law by President Biden.

The new extension (<u>H.R. 6503</u>) runs from Jan. 1 through March 8, following a three-month extension from Sept. 1 to Dec. 31, 2023.

FY 2024 Appropriations Bills

As the deadlines loom, Congress must still wrap up twelve unfinished fiscal year (FY) 2024 appropriations bills. The current continuing resolution (CR) has two expiration dates - Jan. 19 and Feb. 2, with transportation in the earlier tranche.

According to news stories, congressional leaders have reached a deal to avert a partial government shutdown this week by kicking the deadlines to March 1 and 8. This stopgap funding measure would be the third CR since fiscal 2023 funding expired in September last year.
